

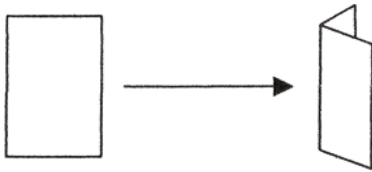
My Daisy Days™

CREATE BLANK BOOKS FOR MY DAISY DAYS EARLY LITERACY

DIRECTIONS FOR FOLDING PAPER TO MAKE AN EIGHT-PAGE BOOK

Supplies: 8-1/2" x 11" sheets of paper for smaller books or larger (11" x 17") for larger books.
Scissors needed to make a single cut.

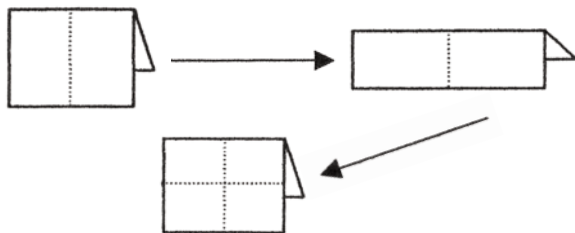
1. Fold the paper in half lengthwise making firm, sharp creases.



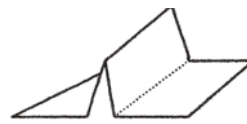
2. Open the sheet and fold the paper in half widthwise.



3. Fold the paper in half again in the same direction. Unfold, keeping the crease at the top and four sections facing you.



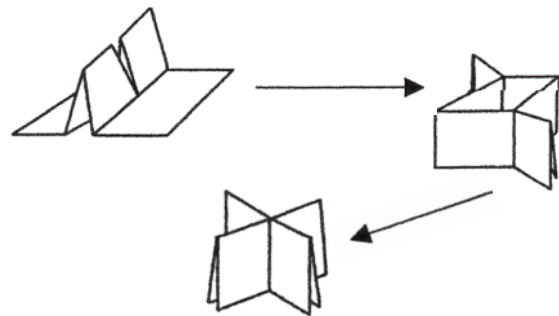
4. Place ends flat on the table so that the center sections stand as a peak.



5. Cut downward from the folded edge to the center crease.



6. Holding the creased edges, pull downward.



7. Close the diamond and fold the "pages" into a book.
